I. ACCESS TO THE QUESTIONNAIRE

1. Teacher will send the **Access link** to the e-mail address provided. Open the link to access the PROFFORMANCE Student Feedback. The message will appear in your inbox.

2. After opening the link, you will be taken to the student questionnaire and asked to enter your personal data as a first step.
