Teaching Competence Enhancement in Higher Education in Croatia

Renata Samo (HR)

- What do you expect from the project? What is your motivation?
 - Exchange of knowledge and experience at international level and participate in international joint good practices.
 - Exploitation of expertise gained at international organizations (HERE, ACA) and make practical use of previous experiences.
 - Increasing the role of quality teaching in higher education besides the current trends of mainly publication-based assessment.



- What could be your contribution to the overall aims, and to the different project results based on your knowledge and experience?
 - Exploitation of various previous experiences gained in the field of higher education, QA, national and international projects and related research activities
 - The previous expertise of the participants covers all main topic areas of the project, from research through policy drafting to translation

- With what results you would be satisfied?
 - The answers reflect a realistic view of the possible results: instead of the full-scale implementation and operation of a working model, a theoretical and practical basis is expected, with benchmarks, main ideas and a solid ground for further research and development
 - Strong emphasis is on international networking opportunities, joint work and establishment of future cooperation

- How will you use the project results in your professional activities/at your institution?
 - The results will be included in the professional work of the participants mainly at institutional level
 - Depending on the final outcome, the results will be disseminated (e.g. theoretical model, tools, etc.) or put into practical use and adopted/further developed locally
 - The experience and expertise gained during the collaboration will be further exploited in the professional careers of participants



- How your participation will be beneficial from your individual/institutional/national point of view?
 - At individual/personal level the main expectation is to gain international experience, and having an insight into the topic from various perspectives; networking is also an important opportunity provided by the project
 - Az institutional level the main goal is to improve the existing QA practices (or establish one in case of no previous one), and exploiting the good practices learned during the project
 - At national level, the institutional examples are expected to put to use at other institutions and to be taken into account during policy making
