Quality of TaL

 Focus on innovative and flexible teaching that supports critical thinking, personalized learning, and lifelong education through micro-credentials.

Internationalization

 Strengthen international study programs, student and staff mobility, and hybrid learning to enhance global accessibility of education.

Human Resources, Student Support and Social Safety

 Invest in academic staff development, softskills training for students, and comprehensive support systems ensuring inclusion and mental well-being.

Digitalization and AI development

 Promote digital and AI-enhanced education through modern e-learning tools, adaptive systems, and improved digital literacy among students and teachers.

Infrastructure Development

 Modernize educational spaces and digital infrastructure to support flexible, technology-driven learning environments.

Knowledge Transfer and Strategic Partnerships

 Connect education with practice by involving external partners, developing dual study models, and integrating new forms of collaboration into curricula.

TEACHING AND LEARNING POLICY INNOVATION – COOPERATION BETWEEN STAKEHOLDERS IN HIGHER EDUCATION POLICY

- Intensive cooperation between the ministry, universities, and a newly more independent quality assurance agency between 2025 and 2027.
- Development of teaching expertise strengthening pedagogical and didactic experts at HEIs through training, mentoring, and systematic development of academic staff's teaching competences
- Building support structures establishing and developing teaching and learning support centers, creating professional development strategies and sharing good practices across institutions.
- Collaboration and internationalization connecting universities into a cooperative network, implementing joint projects, promoting international exchange of experience, and involving foreign experts.
- Common methodological materials, educational modules, expert networks, implemented strategies for teaching competence development and evaluation

SUSTAINABILITY AND TEACHING AND LEARNING

- Green Deal → new study programmes and activities for sustainable development and economy
- development of "green" courses and skills for expanding competences
- clearly defined learning outcomes in the areas of sustainability, climate change, environmental protection with due consideration given to environmental, social, and economic aspects
- program's financial allocation is €40 million for 2024 and 2025
